

A lucky 7 in Striderland for 2020



#1 Covid-19 halted running activities everywhere, starting with the Drake Relays in the Spring continuing through the summer as race after race fell victim. Dam to DSM & Midnight Madness, then in the fall Des Moines Marathon & Living History Farms cancelled. The pademic slowed the running community.



#2 Striderland girls shined at the State Cross Country 4A Championship. Johnston dominated winning their 5th crown in the last 7 years. They were followed on the podium by Valley & Ankeny Centennial. Amazingly in the 3A, local teams excelled. Ballard & Dallas Center-Grimes were 1st & 2nd. The Girls were tops!



#3 The top race in Iowa was small and fast - WR Elite 5K. 18 men broke 15 minutes and 10 women broke 18 minutes. Perfect weather greeted this star studded field on a flat course in Waterworks Park. All-time Iowa records were set . . . proof that competitive racing is alive & well.



#4 Austin O'Brien is the best runner in Striderland. After a DNF at the Olympic Trials Marathon he trained relentlessly, setting PRs in the 5k (14:23) and 10k (29:53). In tough howling winds he posted a 2:21:23 marathon to end the season.



#5 With no Drake Relays in the spring, Drake rose to the challenge with the Blue Oval Showcase at the end of the summer. No fans but plenty of great athletes - a tribute to the Relay tradition.
